With more payment options, and more ways to pay your insurance premium, we let you decide. Choose either monthly, one, or three payments to pay your premium.

The choice is yours.

IDEAL MONTHLY PAYMENT PLAN

Looking for a convenient way to pay your insurance premiums? With the Ideal Monthly Payment Plan, monthly payments are withdrawn automatically from your chequing account with a bank, trust company or credit union. No more cheque writing, postage costs or the possibility of missed payments. A 3% finance fee is applied and included with each installment. We require a void cheque and a completed authorization form (attached). That's it! Each year our offer to renew will indicate the installments for the new policy term.

ONE PAY

Pay your premium in one lump sum at the beginning of your policy and then don't think about it again.

THREE PAY (ANNUAL POLICIES ONLY)

Our Three Pay plan makes budgeting your finances easy. The first installment, 40% of your annual premium, is due when you receive your policy. The second and third installments, for 30% each, are due 3 months and 6 months from the start of the policy. We will send you a bill approximately 3 weeks before the due date of the installment so you don't have to remember when to make your next payment. A 3% finance fee will be applied.

Paying your insurance premium should be easy and convenient. At any time you may choose one of the following options to pay your new policy, renewal or policy change for One Pay and Three Pay policies. (Note: all refunds issued by The Dominion are by cheque regardless of how the payment was made.)

CREDIT CARD

Use your Visa or MasterCard to pay your premium. When you receive your bill, simply fill out the payment stub with your credit card information, sign it and send it back to us for processing.

BANK MACHINE

You can also pay your premium at an automated teller machine (ATM). If you'd rather do your banking in person, most banks, trust companies and credit unions will process your payment at a teller. The payment stub at the bottom of your bill contains specially coded information that ensures that the premium is applied to your policy. Please be sure to include this stub when making payments.

CHEQUE

If you prefer, you may also make your payment by cheque. Please be sure to enclose the payment stub.
